



At a Lexington County General Sessions, convened on May 6, 2024, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

Shoplifting, value more than \$2,000 but less than \$10,000

That in Lexington County, South Carolina, on or about August 18, 2022, the Defendant, William Theoplas Coleman, did take possession of, carry away, transfer from one person to another or from one area of a store or other retail mercantile establishment to another area, or caused to be carried away or transferred, merchandise displayed, held, stored, or offered for sale by a store or other retail mercantile establishment with the intention of depriving the merchant of the possession, use, or benefit of the merchandise without having paid the full retail value and the value of the shoplifted merchandise was more than two thousand dollars but less than ten thousand dollars, to wit: shoplifting several pieces of lawn care equipment valued at over \$3,000, all in violation of Section 16-13-110(A)(1), 16-13-110(B)(2), et al. of the Codes of Law of South Carolina.
