**APPELLANTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

On May 29, 2024, this Court filed its Unpublished Opinion No. 24-UP-194. Appellants Charlesetta S. Aiken and Palmer E. Simmons, individually and as Trustee of the Charles E. Simmons, Jr. and Rosa G. Simmons Revocable Trust dated May 5, 2016, by and through their undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, respectfully

move for an extension of thirty (30) days' time for Appellants to petition for rehearing of this matter.

Rule 221(a), SCACR, provides that “[p]etitions for rehearing must be actually received by the appellate court no later than fifteen (15) days after the filing of the opinion, order, judgment, or decree of the court.” Based on the May 29, 2024, filing of the Court’s opinion in this case, the present deadline to petition for rehearing is Thursday, June 13, 2024.

Appellants respectfully request this Court to allow thirty (30) additional days, until July 15, 2024, for the filing by Appellants of a Petition for Rehearing, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR. The grounds for this motion include the complexity of the issues involved, existing work commitments of the undersigned counsel, including a trial and several appeal deadlines in other matters, as well as planned family vacation time. The undersigned counsel states that there is good cause for this request, and it is not made for the purpose of delay. Respondents have kindly consented to this extension request.

For these reasons, Appellants respectfully request that this Court would grant their request for extension until July 15, 2024.
