Dear Mr. Ivester:

Upon reviewing your filing received on June 3, 2024, which this Court construes as your attempt to file an appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, your brief must be titled as an appellant's initial brief.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal as required by Rule 209, SCACR.
- The cover page of your brief must contain your name and contact information pursuant to Rule 267(a), SCACR.
- Your brief must contain a table of contents and cases, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, standard of review, argument, and conclusion as required by Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR.
- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide

proof of service stating that you have mailed a copy of your appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to the respondent's counsel, M. Stokely Holder.
