ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent Auto-Owners Insurance Company's motion to strike is denied. The merits of the arguments contained in Appellant's brief—including whether they are preserved for review—will be considered by the court following final briefing. Additionally, the items Respondent moves to strike were all presented to the lower court; the inclusion of matters in the record on appeal is unrelated to issue preservation. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").
