I represent Oshaun Robinson on his above referenced PCR appeal. I would respectfully request my second extension of 30 days to timely file and serve the Brief of Respondent. The basis for this extension is as follows.

Upon taking over representation for Mr. Robinson following the interim suspension of Tara Dawn Shurling, Esquire. I have worked diligently to read and understand the lengthy record and numerous appellate filings. Upon receipt of the State's Brief, I have been working on preparing an original work product in drafting the Brief since I did not prepare or file the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Taking over for a suspended attorney at this juncture has required more work than adopting my own Return into a responsive Brief. I have a draft and met with Mr. Robinson yesterday to review, but I need additional time to complete and file.
