

Dear Counsel,

The panel has asked that each party have the opportunity to file a memorandum addressing the immediate appealability of the commission's January 17, 2012 order in light of the supreme court's recent decision in *Bone v. U.S. Food Serv.*, Op. No. 27282 (S.C. Sup. Ct. filed June 26, 2013) (Shearouse Adv. Sh. No. 28 at 49), and the provision in section 1-23-380 of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2012) that a party may have judicial review of "final decision[s] of an agency order." The memoranda should specifically address whether the January 17, 2012 order is a final decision of the commission, and, if not, whether "review of the final agency decision would [] provide an adequate remedy." See *id.* Your memorandum must be filed within ten days of this letter, and you should not expect to receive an extension.
