





ORDER

On April 12, 2024, this appeal was dismissed after Appellant failed to pay the notice of appeal filing fee, file a copy of the order on appeal, and file a proof of service upon the Administrative Law Court and Respondent. On April 19, 2024, Appellant requested that this court waive the filing fee, explaining he is indigent. We construe this filing as a petition to rehear the dismissal. Appellant has still not provided the filing fee, order on appeal, or proof of service.¹ Accordingly, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition is denied.
