1 PROBATION: Before you, Your Honor, you
2 have Michael Gregory Youman, Warrant Number
3 W38230104. He was sentenced on January 12th of
4 2023 in Orangeburg County by the Honorable Judge
5 Taylor under Indictment Number 2022-GS-38-01682 for
6 domestic violence second degree. He was sentenced
7 to three years suspended to two years probation and
8 give him time served for one day.

9 Your Honor, per Orangeburg County
10 Sheriff's Office incident report number
11 2023-001004, the offender was in possession of a
12 firearm and pointed the firearm arm at the current
13 victim of this probation case as well as her under
14 aged son. Prior incident report -- per the
15 incident report, he also was heard on recording
16 threatening to kill her, blow her head off, and put
17 it up her butt.

18 The offender is currently \$300 in
19 arrears on his supervision fees and \$162 on his
20 court fees in arrears. The State is recommending
21 partial revocation of 90 days. However, Your
22 Honor, I do want you to take into consideration
23 that this is the second case with this same victim
24 that he has had as well as him being in possession
25 of the firearm while being on probation for

1 domestic violence. As well as we do have a
2 statement for the victim that the victim advocate
3 can put on record.

4 THE COURT: Okay.

5 MS. HINDS: Your Honor, just so you
6 understand, I'm asking for a continuance because
7 that charge is still pending. And the entirety of
8 the violation pertains to the charge.

9 THE COURT: So he would not be
10 admitting that he's in violation today?

11 MS. HINDS: No. No, sir. And,
12 literally, even on the money, the only reason he's
13 behind on the money is he's been in jail. Got put
14 back in jail right after he pled.

15 THE COURT: All right. I'll hear from
16 the victim's advocate.

17 ADVOCATE: Yes, Your Honor, I have a
18 statement from the victim Khadijah Clifton. It
19 says: Dear Judge, I'm the victim in a domestic
20 violence case against Michael Youman. I'm willing
21 to make a statement in this case, but I won't be
22 able to be present due to work. My eight year old
23 was present when Michael pulled his gun out and
24 threatened to kill me prior to the other incident
25 with the knife. I'm very afraid of him and I

1 | believe he's capable of carrying out his threats.

2 | Also, my child has been traumatized
3 | since and has been having nightmares waking up
4 | saying Fred says he's going to kill my momma. He's
5 | been violent towards me and my child for that past
6 | year we've been together and every time it's worse
7 | than the time before. Thank you for your time,
8 | Khadijah Clifton. End of statement.

9 | THE COURT: All right. Ms. Hinds --
10 | actually, Mr. Youman, have you that had the
11 | opportunity to go over the violation report with
12 | Ms. Hinds?

13 | (No response.)

14 | THE COURT: Have you had the
15 | opportunity to go over the violation report with
16 | Ms. Hinds?

17 | MR. YOUMAN: Yes.

18 | THE COURT: Do you understand why
19 | you're here?

20 | MR. YOUMAN: Yes, sir.

21 | THE COURT: Do you agree or disagree
22 | that you're in violation of the terms of your
23 | probation?

24 | MR. YOUMAN: Yes, sir.






