

Dear Mr. Palmer:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide proof of service on counsel for each respondent.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- You must serve and file a notice of appeal that is substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The notice of appeal must also include a full caption that identifies the appellant and respondent(s).
