ORDER

By order dated April 4, 2024, this Court dismissed the present matter because Petitioner failed to provide proof of service demonstrating that a copy of the notice of appeal had been served on counsel for the State and a written statement indicating the date on which Petitioner received written notice of the lower court's final order. Petitioner has now filed papers, *pro se*, which we construe as a petition to rehear that dismissal. The petition for rehearing is denied. *See* Rule 221(a), SCACR (providing a petition for rehearing must state with particularity the points supposed to have been overlooked or misapprehended by the Court).
