

This appeal arises out of a scheduling order issued by the Administrative Law Court (ALC). The appeal is dismissed as not immediately appealable because the order on appeal is not a final order. *See Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hosp. Auth. v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Env'tl Control*, 387 S.C. 265, 266, 692 S.E.2d 894, 894 (2010) (stating S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-610 provides judicial review may only be sought from a final decision of the ALC).
