This appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court denying the appellant's motion to dismiss because the Workers' Compensation Act does not apply. The appeal is dismissed because the order on appeal is not immediately appealable. *See Deskins v. Boltin*, 319 S.C. 356, 357, 461 S.E.2d 395, 395 (1995) (holding the denial of a motion to dismiss on the ground the action is barred by the exclusivity provision of the Workers' Compensation Act is not immediately appealable).
