Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I am in receipt of the Opinion of the Court and I am back in my office for the second day after an aortic valve replacement and the implantation of a pacemaker. I am under restrictions on use of the left arm/shoulder and have to sleep with an immobilizer at night for the next 30 days. They are taking the staples out Friday and I am planning on being out of the office next week to further recuperate from all the physical aspects of the procedures.

I plan on filing a Petition for Rehearing and am well aware of Rule 221(a), SCACR, which provides that a Petition for Rehearing shall be filed within 15 days. I do not know whether any of the other Rules provide discretion for the Court to grant an extension on the filing of a Petition for Rehearing or if the parties can by agreement, extend the time to file a Petition for Rehearing. I would appreciate it if you would bring this to the attention of the Chief Judge and let me know today, and I will stop everything else and get the Petition out by Friday. I would also ask Mr. Baxley on a preliminary basis if he would be agreeable to an extension by agreement.

I sincerely apologize for having to make this request but I am sure the Court understands. As always, I appreciate all the courtesies and kindnesses shown to me by you, your office, and the Court.
