MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rules 240 and 263(b), S.C.A.C.R., the Appellant, by her counsel herein, moves this Court for an order granting her an extension of time in which to file her Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal, on the grounds stated below:

1. By an extension granted by the Court, and by reason of counsel for Appellant's diagnosis of Covid, the Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record is set as due as of June 21st, 2024.
2.
