Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Emanuel Williams with the Court of Appeals on May 29, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders



Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Vance Ross v. State with the Supreme Court on March 18, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Philip David Guderyon with the Supreme Court on March 12, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Steven L. Reynolds v. State with the Supreme Court on March 8, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Sidney Antoine Holmes v. State with the Supreme Court on March 8, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Andres F. Posso with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Desmond Cromer v. State with the Supreme Court on March 4, 2024.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that her caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. On May 30, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through June 30, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for serving and filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


