MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Dalonte Green respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 29, 2024**, in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Dalonte Green respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Maurice Mitchell v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 12, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Don Leequin Brown with the Court of Appeals on June 12, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Alexander Rhue, Jr. before the Supreme Court on June 6, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of respondent and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Christopher Quick with the Court of Appeals on June 4, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Olandio Workman before the Supreme Court on May 22, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Jason Edwin Stoots before the Supreme Court on May 21, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of The State v. Terrell Denard Knightner with the Supreme Court on May 17, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Francisco R. Rodriguez v. The State before the Court of Appeals on May 8, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Lindy Lamont Jones v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 1, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of Willie Marvin Williams v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 29, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty-day general consent granted by email from Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka dated May 30, 2024 for all Appellate Defense extensions through June 30, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 29, 2024**, in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
