## ORDER

On May 28, 2024, Respondent-Appellant filed a motion for leave to file a motion pursuant to Rule 60(a) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure for relief from the circuit court's February 7, 2023 order. The February 7, 2023 order was a Form 4 order in which the circuit court checked a box indicating the order ended the case, and Respondent-Appellant contends "the checking of this box on the February 7, 2023 Form 4 was a mere clerical error by the [circuit] court." Appellants-Respondents did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent-Appellant's motion. Within fifteen days of the date of this order, Respondent-Appellant shall file and serve its Rule 60(a) motion. Further, Respondent-Appellant must provide this court with status updates every thirty days. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of the cross-appeal.
