Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I write to make sure we comply with the Court's request in the attached June 28, 2024 letter.

Both parties have previously electronically filed final briefs.

By my reading of the current version of Rule 211(a), a separate certificate of Rule 211(b) compliance is no longer required: "The signature [on the final brief] constitutes a certificate that the final brief(s) complies with Rule 211(b)." Rule 211(a), SCACR.

Nevertheless, after the briefs were electronically filed, as belt and suspenders, both parties SEPARATELY filed a certificate of Rule 211(b) compliance.

In the attached letter, the Court directs that, among other things, the parties file one set of bound copies of final briefs.

The Court's attached letter notes the the bound final briefs should include a Rule 211(b) certificate of counsel for the final brief. This would make them different from the electronically filed briefs. I assume this instruction is carried over from an earlier time and that our bound copies do not need to add in the previous separately filed certificates.

I am on vacation this week and the requested bound copies are due the day of my return. I simply wanted to avoid a re-do. I want to not order the wrong things bound this week, and will assume I am correct in leaving out the unnecessary certificates unless the Court advises otherwise.
