Appellant's Statement of Facts

The defendant was charged in Lancaster County General Sessions Court with two counts of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor and three counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct with a minor, Second Degree from an incident occurring in Lancaster County on or about May 29, 2023.

The defendant, after consultation with his attorney, agreed to enter a plea of guilty to the charges with a recommended sentence of Fifteen (15) years in the Department of Corrections. On June 7, 2024, The Honorable Donald B. Hocker accepted the plea and sentenced the defendant to Thirteen (13) years in the Department of Corrections, all sentences to run concurrent.

The Public Defender's Office received a letter from Mr. Wright dated June 12, 2024 requesting an appeal. It appears that the letter was mailed on June 13, 2024 from the Kirkland facility in Columbia, South Carolina; however, our office did not receive the letter until after business hours on June 20, 2024.

Issues on Appeal

Subsequent to his guilty plea, the defendant requested his counsel to file an appeal regarding this plea. Pursuant to Rule 203(b)(2) and(d) SCACR, defendant's counsel is filing this appeal.

However, after a review of the facts of this case and guilty plea, defendant's counsel finds there is no issue for appeal and believes it to be without merit.

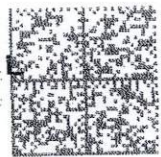
