## ORDER

On June 3, 2024, Respondent moved to strike the record on appeal, arguing Appellant failed to include certain items designated by Respondent and included items not designated by either party. Appellant filed a return, and Respondent filed a reply. Thereafter, Appellant filed a motion to supplement the record, Respondent filed a return opposing the motion to supplement, and Appellant filed a reply. On June 10, 2024, Appellant filed a motion to supplement the record with Appellant's objection to motion to consolidate filed July 16, 2021. Respondent filed a return, opposing the motion to supplement, and Appellant filed a reply. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to strike the record on appeal, require Appellant provide the omitted designated matter to this court in a supplemental record on appeal, and grant the motion to supplement the record. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file and serve a supplemental record on appeal that includes Exhibits A-D to Respondent's designated matter 1; Exhibits A-D to Respondent's designated matter 2; Exhibit A to Respondent's designated matter 8; Exhibits A-B to Respondent's designated matter 9; Respondent's designated matter 16; Respondent's designated matter 18; Exhibits A-D to Respondent's designated matter 19; Respondent's designated matter 23; Exhibits A-D to Respondent's designated matter 23; and Appellant's objection to the motion to consolidate filed July 16, 2021. Within twenty days of the date of service of the

supplemental record on appeal, the parties shall file their final briefs. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
