MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Randy E. Self respectfully requests a **fifth and final thirteen (13) business day extension from July 5, 2024, until July 24, 2024**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. **Counsel will file the brief and designation before this requested deadline if possible.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fifth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Randy E. Self respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances

exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel was a faculty trainer specializing in preserving trial issues for appeal at the PD 103 CLE seminar at the Greenville County Courthouse this week from July 1-3, 2024. Counsel filed the three issue Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Christopher Moore v. The State with the Supreme Court on Friday, June 28, 2024. Counsel presented on the Case Law Update at the Indigent Defense CLE on June 21, 2024, in Columbia. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Shana Robinson v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 10, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Cory Allen v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 6, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Cornelius J. Staggers with this Court on May 24, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Freddy Ray Harris with this Court on May 9, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Mason Yarborough with this Court on May 1, 2024. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested. **Counsel regrets the necessity of this fifth extension request, and he will file the brief and designation in this case before this requested deadline if possible.**




