ORDER

On April 29, 2024, this court ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal within thirty days of the date of the order. Appellant failed to do so. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss on June 4, 2024. Appellant did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to dismiss due to Appellant's failure to serve and file an amended record on appeal by May 29, 2024. *See* Rule 260(a), SCACR ("Whenever it appears that an appellant . . . has failed to comply with the requirements of these [r]ules, the clerk shall issue an order of dismissal . . ."). Remittitur will issue as provided in Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Respondent's request for fees and costs is denied without prejudice as premature. *See* Rule 222(d), SCACR ("A party desiring costs to be taxed shall, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of the remittitur, serve and file a motion requesting that costs be assessed under this [r]ule.").
