

ORDER

On May 28, 2024, Appellant filed the record on appeal in this matter. On May 31, 2024, Respondents filed their second joint motion to correct deficiencies in the record on appeal, explaining the record on appeal is not numbered.¹ No return was filed. After careful consideration, we grant Respondents' second joint motion to correct deficiencies in the record on appeal and strike the record on appeal filed on May 28, 2024. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("Each page of the [r]ecord on [a]ppeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index."). Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file and serve an amended record on appeal that complies with Rule 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Failure

¹ We note this court sent a letter to Appellant on May 31, 2024, explaining his proof of service for the record on appeal was deficient. As explained in that letter, Appellant must serve Respondent via United States Mail. *See* Rule 262(c)(3), SCACR; *Re: Methods of Electronic Filing & Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules*, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated August 25, 2021 (Howard Adv. Sh. No. 30) (providing that only lawyers admitted to practice in South Carolina may serve other lawyers using the lawyer's primary email address in AIS). We take this opportunity to remind Appellant that in addition to serving Respondent via United States Mail, he must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
