1. Counsel Kathrine H. Hudgins is appointed Counsel for appellate case 2012 21 3219
2. Appellant Trial Court Sentence is in violation of South Carolina Code of Laws 1976 title 17-25-20 for conviction on 10-1-80 attempt.
