
Plaintiff Terron Gerhard Dizzley moves before this Honorable Court with a Notice of Appeal in the above matter from the Order Granting Motions To Dismiss Defendants issued by Judge Bentley Price on May 8, 2024. Plaintiff received order on May 16, 2024. On May 21, 2024, Plaintiff filed a Motion For Extension of Time To File Motion To Alter, Amend, Correct, Reconsideration because he sent the Motion To Alter Amend... to his mother to file prior and did not know if it would arrive in time to meet the deadline. However Plaintiff's mother received the Motion To Alter, Amend, Correct, Reconsideration on May 21, 2024 and filed it on May 21, 2024. On the same day of May 21, 2024 Plaintiff was assaulted Correctional Officers at Allendale Corrections in retaliation for filing these civil actions and placed in solitary confinement and afterwards administration fabricated false charges against Plaintiff. On June 6, 2024 Plaintiff received a letter from the Georgetown County

Clerk of Court and his mother informing Plaintiff that the Georgetown County Clerk of Court refuses to file any documents from Plaintiff pursuant to this case. Therefore, the Georgetown County Clerks of Court are intentionally depriving Plaintiff of his rights to Due Process under the Fourteenth Amendment and First Amendment right to access the courts.

Plaintiff also filed a Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis and an Ex parte Motion Requesting To Be Granted Funds To Pay For April 18, 2024 Hearing. The Transcript from this hearing proves that Judge Price deprived Plaintiff from presenting his case and told Defendants Attorney's to draw up a Proposed Order Dismissing the case. Judge Bentley signed the Proposed Order which fails to address the merits of Plaintiff's issues which proves that he is being held Kidnapped / falsely imprisoned by SCDC without any legal nor jurisdictional authority. Over the years Plaintiff has filed countless Petitions (Emergency) for his immediate release from being held falsely imprisoned informing the courts that he would suffer "irreparable harm" if he did <sup>not</sup> receive an emergency hearing that is fair and complies with due process and that he receives a ruling on the merits of his case that complies with SCRPC, Rule 52(a). However, the Courts has failed to do so. Plaintiff contends the he fears for his life, being held in prison illegally which

is Kidnapping, being assaulted by administration on countless occasions, this is the third time that Plaintiff has been assaulted by prison administration, and the second "Hungerstrike" Plaintiff has been on to bring awareness to his illegal incarceration all while the Courts turns a "blind eye" to the terrorist acts being committed against him.

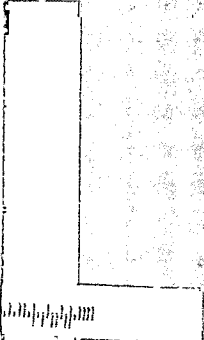
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
