**MOTION TO AMEND DESIGNATION OF MATTER;  
SERVE AND FILE SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD ON APPEAL;  
AND HOLD APPEAL IN ABEYANCE**

Respondent, through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto this Court as follows:

I.

In trying to complete the Final Brief of Respondent, the undersigned realized he failed to include several relevant pages of the trial transcript in the State's Designation of Matter. The pages are cited to in the State's Brief of Respondent, are proper for inclusion in the Record on Appeal, and are necessary to present a complete picture for the Court. The Amended Designation of Matter is filed with this Motion.

II.

The State asks to amend its Designation of Matter to include Trial Transcript pages 329-341. The State asks permission to prepare a Supplemental Record on Appeal, and seeks ten days from the date of the Court's Order to serve and file the Supplemental

Record on Appeal. The State asks the Court to hold the current appeal in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion, and allow the State twenty days from the service of the Supplemental Record on Appeal to serve and file the Final Brief of Respondent. This motion is not intended to cause delay, but is intended to properly present the full case to the Court and for the State to properly complete its Final Brief of Respondent.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court allow the amendment of the State's Designation of Matter to include pages 329-341 of the trial transcript; allow the State to serve and file a Supplemental Record on Appeal within ten days of the date of the Court's Order; hold this appeal in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion and allow the State twenty days from the service of the Supplemental Record on Appeal to serve and file the Final Brief of Respondent; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
