

ORDER

On March 12, 2024, this court granted a temporary stay of the circuit court's order affirming a magistrate's issuance of an order of eviction, remanded the matter to the circuit court for a hearing on Appellant's motion to stay, and ordered Appellant to notify this court within ten days of receiving the circuit court's ruling on the motion to stay. On April 24, 2024, this court sent a letter to Appellant requesting an update on the status of the motion to stay pending in the circuit court within ten days of the date of the letter and warning the appeal would be dismissed if Appellant failed to comply. On May 24, 2024, this court lifted the temporary stay and dismissed the appeal because Appellant did not provide a status update. On June 4, 2024, Appellant filed a motion to reinstate the appeal, explaining she did not receive this court's April 24, 2024 letter requesting a status update. Appellant further explained that on March 21, 2024, the circuit court issued an order granting a bond to stay the order of eviction during the pendency of the appeal. On June 24, 2024, Respondent filed a motion to file a return to the motion to reinstate out of time and a return. Respondent requested this court deny the motion to reinstate. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to file a return out of time. The return is hereby accepted. Further, Appellant's motion to reinstate the appeal is granted.
