

## ORDER

---

On April 29, 2024, Appellant filed a notice of appeal seeking review of a decision by an administrative law judge. Appellant sought to be paid pursuant to the prevailing wage statute for work performed as part of an industry within the South Carolina Department of Corrections. On June 28, 2024, Appellant filed a motion for the appointment of counsel. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion for the appointment of counsel. *See* Rule 608(g), SCACR (providing that counsel should not be appointed for an indigent unless the indigent has a right to appointed counsel under the state or federal constitution, a statute, a court rule, or the case law of this state); *Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 310 S.E.2d 440 (Ct. App. 1983) (holding there is no constitutional right to counsel in civil cases).
