

ORDER

This appeal arises out of writ of ejectment issued by the circuit court. The notice of appeal indicates counsel received written notice of entry of the order on appeal on May 29, 2024. The notice of appeal was not served until July 1, 2024, which is more than 30 days after receipt of written notice. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed for the failure to timely serve the notice of appeal. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR (noting a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within 30 days after receipt of written notice); *Elam v. S.C. Dep't of Transp.*, 361 S.C. 9, 14-15, 602 S.E.2d 772, 775 (2004) ("The requirement of service of the notice of appeal is jurisdictional, *i.e.*, if a party misses the deadline, the appellate court lacks jurisdiction to consider the appeal. . . ."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
