**MOTION FOR ORDER PERMITTING APPELLANT TO COME INTO
COMPLIANCE WITH SCACR, RULE 202 AND RULE 208(b)(1)(A)&(B)**

Appellant respectfully moves this Court to allow him to Amend his Designation Of Matter and to Amend and/or Supplement, his Initial Brief so as to properly comply with SCACR, Rule 202 and Rule 208(b)(1)(A)&(B).

On July 5, 2024, Appellant filed the Initial Brief Of Appellant in this matter with his Designation Of Matter To Be Included In The Record On Appeal, believing that he had complied with Appellate Court Rules.

On July 12, 2024, Appellant received from the Clerk of Court for the S.C. Court of Appeals, "APPELLANT'S RECORD ON APPEAL" that he had filed prematurely with his Initial Brief and Designation of Matter.

Appellant also received from the clerk, a copy of his Initial Brief and two (2) Orders entered on July 8, 2024, one of which informed him of his error in prematurely filing the Record On Appeal and the other Granting

his motion for extension of time In which to provide the Initial Brief of Appellant and the Designation Of Matter and accepting the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter as being filed.

Appellant reviewed the copies sent to him, recognized that he had failed to include in his Initial Brief, a "Table Of Contents," "Table Of Authorities," and "Issues On Appeal," which he had erroneously left in his own record folder. He also recognized that his Designation Of Matter does not appear to be properly certified, and Appellant now files this Motion, with an attached corrected Designation Of Matter, a Corrected Initial Brief Of Appellant cover sheet, and Pages i, ii, and iii of his Initial Brief.

Appellant includes a corrected Cover Sheet to replace the Cover Sheet previously filed because of the typing errors on that previously filed Cover Sheet that Appellant corrected with a pen at the Mail Room Window as he was hurriedly trying to mail out his documents.

Appellant submits that the Respondent is not being prejudiced in any way by these corrections and Appellant apologizes for any inconvenience his errors may have caused and asks this Court to please allow the corrections to be made to his Initial Brief and the Designation of Matter.

WHEREFORE, Appellant Prays that this Honorable Court accept these five (5) pages as an Amendment and/or Supplement to his Designation Of Matter and his Initial Brief, and accordingly, issue an appropriate Order permitting same.

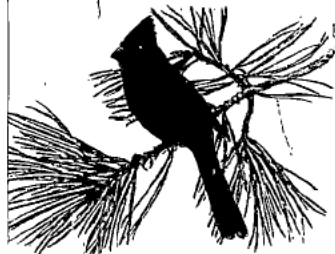
