

Dear Marshall and Kathy:

I am writing this formal letter to you in regards to what transpired yesterday. Namely - I went to the Lieber Corr. Inst. mailroom to sign for my discovery from Scott D. Robinson, Esq.; Ms. Bryant, the mailroom personell, denied me to have this discovery, stating that it would have to go to SCDC Headquarters for examination.

I regret that all of your efforts to help me attain the discovery were so trumped, and for no clear reason. As you well know there is information pertinent to my appeal within that discovery. Also, there are vital papers and documents in that discovery which I need now to resolve conflicts of record and some clear error and other merittas issues.

I am wondering now, if there is not some sort of conspiracy or a partnership between the state of S.C. and the SCDC to thwart inmates' attempts to fight there cases and win their freedom.

I have enclosed all letters I have sent to other parties. I ask that you contact Susan Hackett by phone and with a follow up letter, requesting, with my permission, that my appeal be held in stay and abeyance until this matter is remedied as I cannot wait weeks to get this discovery back because I have a pending court deadline now. I have notified SCDC that they will be held liable for any missing effects or documents from my Rule 5/Brady Discovery that was taken.


Dear Mr. Tatarsky:

I am again forced to write you concerning the above case. On 19 August, 2013, I received my "Discovery" motion from former trial counsel Scott D. Robinson, Esq., at the Lieber Correctional Institution ("LCI") mailroom.

Upon receipt of my discovery, LCI mailroom clerk Ms. L. Bryant, kept and censored my discovery and advised me that she had to forward the entire Rule 5/Brady Discovery to SCDC Headquarters for review, examination, and censorship. Upon seizing my discovery I was not given an index of total pages contained within the discovery package.

Now, GOD only knows when I will receive my discovery package from SCDC Headquarters - when, and if it does come back, I WILL HAVE NO WAY OF KNOWING WHAT HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM MY DISCOVERY. Should I then sign for that discovery package, I'm accepting that discovery package as complete. I now request that a) the mailroom supervisor at LCI verify said contents of the discovery with my former trial attorney Scott D. Robinson, Esq. before I sign and accept as complete and b) that the SCDC General Counsel number the pages and include a spreadsheet/checklist of the contents.

The discovery is crucial to establishing that my Record on Appeal is inaccurate, incomplete, as also it contains documents pertinent to various meritorious issues. Without this discovery I cannot effectively perfect my appeal.
