Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted. See *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995) (the right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right); *Tant v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 408 S.C. 334, 341, 759 S.E.2d 398, 401 (2014) ("There can be no doubt the length of an inmate's incarceration implicates a constitutional liberty interest.").
