## ORDER



On May 20, 2024, Appellant filed a motion for limited remand for reconvening mediation. Appellant notes Respondents "filed a new lawsuit against [Appellant] that is directly related to, and derivative of, the issues litigated in the instant action." Thus, Appellant argues remanding this case would allow the parties to resolve this case and the newly-filed lawsuit through mediation at the same time. Respondents filed a return, opposing remanding the case for reconvening mediation and explaining Respondents "do not wish to mediate this case again" and do not "believe a second mediation would be fruitful." Both parties agree this case was mediated previously, and that mediation was unsuccessful. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion for limited remand for reconvening mediation.

On June 14, 2024, Appellant moved for an extension of time to file and serve his initial brief and designation of matter in light of the pending motion to remand, noting a remand may render the filing of the initial brief and designation of matter moot if mediation resolved the issues on appeal. Respondents filed a return, opposing an indefinite extension of time, but not opposing a definite extension of time. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant a definite extension of time. Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter shall be served and filed within thirty days of the date of this order. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
