The specific requirements are outlined in Rule 404 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) and are available at [www.sccourts.org/courtreg](http://www.sccourts.org/courtreg). Additionally, the application form appears directly below the rule on the website.


The **original** application for admission pro hac vice with an **original** certificate of good standing of the Bar from the highest court of any state or the District of Columbia in which you are admitted to practice law must be filed with this Court. A **copy** of the completed application form, including the \$250 filing fee and any

required attachments, must be filed with the South Carolina Supreme Court Office of Bar Admissions. The Clerk of the Supreme Court will certify to this Court that the completed application and fee have been received.

In addition, the South Carolina attorney with whom you will be associated must serve and file a motion to admit you pro hac vice. The motion must be in compliance with the requirements of Rule 240, SCACR, to include the original motion, six copies, proof of service on all other parties, and the filing fee of \$25.

The required documents should be served and filed within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. If you have any questions, please contact this office.
