
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on August 6, 2007 the Grand Jurors of Charleston County present upon their oath:

Trafficking Cocaine Base Crack

That in Charleston County, South Carolina, on or about May 4, 2007, the Defendant, STANFORD LAVELLE BROWN, knowingly did sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State; or did possess or attempt to possess a controlled substance or a controlled substance analogue, to wit: Cocaine Base Crack, in excess of 10 grams; in violation of 44-53-375 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
