Dear Justice Toal:

Your Hon. I have encountered some unfortunate circumstances here in South Carolina. I was arrested driving a vehicle that belonged to a known member and leader of a prominent street gang called the "Bloods" tray-nine sec from Harlem New York City. That vehicle contained Heroin in the very back of the van which is what I was charged with [2005. GS. 46. 3486 - 3487] in York County, S.C.

The leader of the "Bloods" has ties to New York, Connecticut, North Carolina and South Carolina and other locations on the East Coast. Once I was arrested the leader secured representation for my bond hearing only and posted my bond with a Bondsman named Corey Wright from C.J's bonding company from Columbia, S.C. Subsequently, after being bonded out, the leader threatened my life and the life of my family in New York. I was told that my only option was to leave the State of South Carolina and not to return.

My life was threatened because I witnessed an unsolved murder by the leader and another Blood member called "Ride or die" from New York as well. At a strip club here

On the South is where they killed "G" they know that I have that information and the weapons had traveled across state lines, Your Honor this is the true reason why I was tried in my absence and given (25) years with a sealed sentence. Justice Toal the leader is in prison here in South Carolina on unrelated Drug Charges. I have tangible evidence and information which can be corroborated concerning this unsolved murder, and trafficking of Heroin from the leader's supplier in New York City. It's a Guy from Senegal West Africa that owns a taxi service in Harlem. His name is Barba Diop a.k.a. 64. He distributed vast quantities of heroin to the leader of the Bloods. I was afraid for my life and I would like to speak with someone here in South Carolina, to discuss this information in more detail. Justice Toal I have 25 years for someone else's drugs. Please direct me to the proper agency. I thank you in advance and look forward to hearing something soon. Thank you.
