ORDER

On May 22, 2024, this court issued an opinion, affirming the circuit court's order. On June 6, 2024, Appellant filed a petition for rehearing.¹ After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing from the court's May 22, 2024 opinion. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.

¹ On May 8, 2024, this court granted in part and denied in part a motion filed by Appellant on April 26, 2024. In his June 6, 2024 petition for rehearing, Appellant asked this court to rehear the May 8, 2024 order as well. We take no action on Appellant's petition for rehearing from this court's May 8, 2024 order. *See* Rule 221(c), SCACR ("The appellate court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal.").
