Upon consideration of the arguments presented during Plaintiff Haley Fordham’s (“Plaintiff”) Motion for Entry of Default held on April 18, 2024, with the Honorable George M. McFaddin Jr. presiding, this Court hereby makes the following findings of fact:

Findings of Fact:

1. Plaintiff, by and through her undersigned counsel, filed her summons and complaint on July 14, 2023.
2. On July 25, 2023, Defendant Andrew Hauser was properly served individually and as agent-in-fact on behalf of Defendant Bubba Plum, LLC.
3. On July 21, 2023, Plaintiff’s counsel, Thomas Krahe II, and attorney for Defendant Hauser, G. Hamlin Okelley, III, Esquire agreed to an extension to file the Answer putting the deadline to September 14, 2023.
4. Defendant failed to file an Answer or respond to the same by agreed upon extended deadline of September 14, 2023.
5. On September 15, 2023, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Default Judgment against both Defendants.
6. On October 24, 2023, Defendant Hauser filed an Answer to Plaintiff’s Complaint.

7. On May 6, 2023, the Honorable George M. McFaddin Jr. of the Court of Common Pleas for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of the State of South Carolina issued an order granting Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment.
8. On May 8, 2023, Defendant Hauser filed a Motion to Reconsider with the court.
9. On May 30, 2024, the Honorable George M. McFaddin Jr. of the Court of Common Pleas for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of the State of South Carolina issued a response declining Defendant's Motion to Reconsider.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Plaintiff's Motion for Entry of Default is hereby granted on all claims against Defendants.
2. Defendant's Motion to Reconsider is hereby denied.
3. Plaintiff is entitled to a hearing to determine damages to be scheduled by the Clerk of Court.
