ORDER

Petitioner filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his application for post-conviction relief (PCR). In the explanation required by 243(c), SCACR, Petitioner has failed to show there is an arguable basis for asserting that the dismissal of his PCR application was improper. Therefore, we dismiss the notice of appeal in this matter. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.

Additionally, we prohibit Petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including PCR actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to the previously filed collateral actions, challenging his murder conviction and sentence on Indictment No. 2001-GS-18-00325 and any motions in the underlying criminal case, including a motion pursuant to Rule 29, SCRCrimP, without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.
