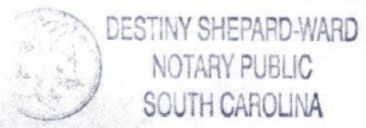

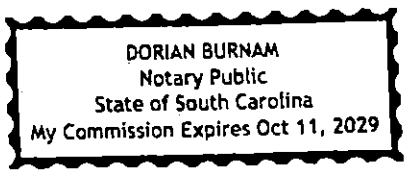

There is NO form for in forma pauperism which was confirmed by the South Carolina Court of appeals I added the original informs pauses from Greenville county clerk ~~the~~ court of appeals held up of doctor Castriotta due to judge Verdin's perjury and racism whom got promoted from Greenville county clerk to SC Court of Appeals yall not about to sent me a bunch of false definceses to try to dismiss my case just like did last time in the Dr castriotta case and now on June 11/2024 I cant get in contact with the sc Court Of appeals Now I will send Form 1 and Form 2 which have already been sent and received by all parties in this case and yall are committing perjury to deny it In Response to the letter sent June 7 2024 DEFICIENCIES I received this letter June 11 the 2024 I corrected all the deficiencies and sent it back which yall received on May 6 the A form 1 and form 7 was sent to both the court of appeals and the defendant and the Greenville county clerk on 5/2/24 and the court of appeals are committing perjury in this letter dated June 7 2024 stating yall didn't receive the documents u sent In 5/2/24 I also called court if of appeals on 5/30/24 to confirm that she received all of my documents which she stated that she had indeed received them and I corrected all the defienicies and my grandmother passed later that night I asked that this no trespassing be removed due to me taking care of her and I wanted to be there in case anything happened to her I expressed that in my motions to the judge and that's why I was hoping that this was resolved in justice before anything happened to her and that why I was suing for emotional distress because my grandmother was the loved one I was talking about accusing me ongoing emotional distress because I was with her though all her treatments and was assisting her in her appointments yall took something for me that I will never get back a chance with my grandmother on her dying bed to be there with her as she transition this has caused EXTREME emotional distress that money cannot equate I had to see my grandmother when she was gone didn't get to see her beautiful eyes or tell her I loved her and this was all done for me expressing my 1st amendment in which was stated in the compliance that I had the right to advocate my mother's wishes I have the rights to sue SAINT FRANSIS but during my mother's hospitalization AND MY FATHER ALSO I LEARNED THAT THE hospitals and courts having been conspiring to target my family and the fact that my grandmother was KILLED due to intentional malice of undergoing a procedure that was unnecessary when the cause of her illness was the biopsy's NOT her cancer all of you that co conspired will be held accountable This hospital SAINT FRANCIS has caused me EXTREME emotional distress intentionally and my grandmother was targeted as retaliation just like my mother and intentionally subjected to unnecessary treatments and her lung was punctured during a unnecessary biopsy they have done three or two biopsy on my grandmother within the last couple of months and all the blood clots and pneumonia I expressed to the judge was in direct correlation to the BIOSPYS which all came back negative a competent doctor would not have done this procedure seeing as she had bacterial infection in her lungs and bloodclots this was MURDER my grandmother didn't die from cancer her test was NEGATIVE and they punctured her lung on top of it all you will be held accountable all of you will NOT get away with MURDERING our loved ones during intentional MALPRACTICE all of yall are bonded and finically responsible this is the purpose for yall going to school 8 and 9 years so that yall can be held finically responsible though yall bond and even judges through yall oaths and bonds and I told them this was unnecessary and that she was too weak at her discharge visit she had a serious bacterial infection in her lungs and blood clots prior to them

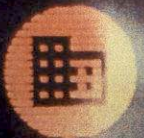
The risks of an open lung biopsy may include:

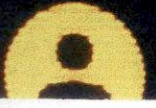

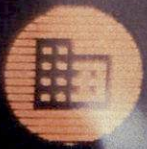

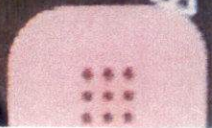
