On August 13, 2024, the State moved to strike the Record on Appeal filed in the above-referenced criminal appeal. The basis for the State's motion was: (1) based on records and information received from and verified by the Beaufort County Clerk of Court's Office, the State believed the Record on Appeal as filed contained matter that was not actually before the trial court; and (2) the Record on Appeal contained unredacted personal data identifiers that required redaction. At present, the State's motion to strike is currently pending in this Court.

Please be advised that, based on information provided by counsel for Appellant and confirmed by the Beaufort County Clerk of Court's Office subsequent to the filing of the State's motion to strike, the exhibit copies originally provided to the State were incomplete and the matter contained in the Record on Appeal as filed does, in fact, accurately reflect what was before the trial court. Furthermore, please be advised that, in response to the State's motion to strike, counsel for Appellant has now filed a properly redacted copy of the Record on Appeal. For those reasons, the State now wishes to withdraw its previously filed motion to strike and respectfully asks this Court to permit it to do so.
