I am writing so that we can all be on the same page regarding this matter and specifically the currently scheduled eviction.

Specifically, I am writing to provide each of you with actual notice that the above-referenced matter is in fact very much still alive, kicking, and pending before the Court of Appeals. As such, I am politely requesting that the eviction scheduled for tomorrow at 9am be postponed pending a final decision by the Court. Please don't rush to judgement to evict tomorrow as doing so would be premature, improper, and not supported by the laws/equities of our State.

If you understandably require corroborating evidence from me regarding what I stated above, look no further than the attached letter from the Court of Appeals just yesterday in which you can see the court is entertaining my clients' motion to reinstate the appeal. Additionally, I've cc'd South Carolina Court of Appeals Specialist 1 Ms. Khee'Asia Evans-Pryor on this matter who just confirmed for me that the court is going to entertain my clients' motion to reinstate so long as I pay the \$50 filing fee by August 22<sup>nd</sup>. Of course, I'm going to pay that fee, and I'm going to do so via overnight UPS or FedEx maybe today but definitely no later than tomorrow either of which will guarantee its arrival well before the earliest this matter could be dismissed on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Ms. Evans-Pryor invites y'all to call her to confirm what I am stating here concerning the fact that the appeal is still pending thereby staying the eviction. Last but not least, you can see in the second attachment which is a screenshot of the SC E-File Docket that this matter is still pending (please excuse the second screen of my daughters and me as I'm not the best with editing photos and I know we're on a time crunch).

Please let me know if y'all have any questions or concerns. Otherwise, I again kindly ask that y'all cancel the eviction for tomorrow so that this matter can be properly decided by the court with finality (or the parties settle). Can y'all please reply all to this email to let us know whether y'all will cancel it or whether y'all are going to go forward with it even in light of everything presented to you.
