Good morning.

According to the attached letter of August 6 you sent last week, the parties' Returns to each other's Petitions for Rehearing will be due ten days later on Friday, August 16. I am writing to confirm that this deadline will not be affected by the Supreme Court's Order of August 6. That Order declared several days last week as holidays due to the impact of Tropical Storm Debby. I am thinking that the Order does not alter the deadline of the 16<sup>th</sup> because ten rather than seven days are allowed for the response so intervening holidays are not excluded under Rule 263, and the deadline does not fall on a holiday.

I am fine with the deadline of August 16, but would appreciate confirmation of the due date.
