KELSEY MOTION FOR ACCESS TO REVIEW  
PAROLE FILE FOR INACCURACIES

Bernard Bagley, pro se, respectfully request the Court to authorize the Respondent to allow him access to review his parole file for any inaccuracies that perhaps influenced the Parole Board (Board) to deny him parole.

Bagley received a letter dated 6/26/24, in response to his letter dated 6/14/24, addressed to the parole officials requesting access to his file for inaccuracies in accordance to *Kelsey v. SCDPPPS*, 441 S.C. 373, 893 S.E.2d 588 (8/30/23). However, in response to his request, Respondent's General Counsel informed him that:

"Because parole files are not final until two weeks before the hearing, after which the files are then redacted, parole files are being available to the inmates and their attorneys on the day of the hearing at the institutions. At which time, you will have the opportunity to address any concerns you may have with the Parole Board at your hearing" (Buchanan, M.C., 2024).

Bagley avers that the file is made available only a few minutes for inmates to review prior to the hearing. Inmates may have only a few minutes to review the file prior appearing before the Board Members. There is no meaningful time or opportunity to do so.

Movant/Appellant respectfully that he be allowed to review his file for any past inaccuracies, and in an effort to address any inaccuracies intelligently with a meaningful inquiry without rushing, atleast thirty or twenty minutes to review his file.



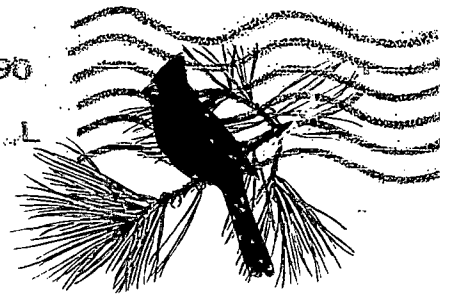
