MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Wayne Hankinson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from August 21, 2024, until September 20, 2024, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Wayne Hankinson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of William Craig Caughman v. State with the Supreme Court on August 16, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Jonathan Hughes v. State with the Supreme Court on July 31, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Kenny Octavis Ruff v. State with the Supreme Court on July 24, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Amber Manning with the Court of Appeals on July 5, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On July 29, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through August 31, 2024.
