**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AND SERVE APPELLANT'S
RECORD OF APPEAL**

1. The Appellant's Record on Appeal is due to be served and filed today, August 26, 2024. Previous extensions were granted on July 11, 2024, due to the Appellant's counsel's heavy workload, and on August 12, 2024, because counsel contracted COVID-19 and her office was closed for a week due to flooding associated with Tropical Storm Debby.
