MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of In the Matter of James G. Younger with the Court of Appeals on July 18, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Xavier Polite with the Court of Appeals on July 17, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Phillip Lawson with the Court of Appeals on July 3, 2024. Counsel was a speaker at the Case Law Update CLE on June 21, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Alonza Marable with the Court of Appeals on June 21, 2024. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Tommy Long with the Court of Appeals on June 3, 2024. Counsel presented oral argument in the case of The State v. Ricky Bernard Brown before the Court of Appeals on June 3, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On July 29, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through August 31, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension from August 28, 2024, until September 27, 2024, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for serving and filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
