MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Daniel Demond Griffin respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until October 4, 2013**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fifth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Daniel Demond Griffin respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. 

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




