

ORDER

On March 14, 2024, Appellant filed a notice of appeal from an administrative law court's order regarding his claim to a prevailing wage. On July 3, 2024, Respondent informed this court that the parties reached a settlement and requested "that, assuming no objection is received from Appellant in the next thirty days, the case be dismissed." Appellant filed a return on July 22, 2024, objecting to the dismissal of his appeal and explaining his understanding of the terms of the settlement agreement, which differed from Respondent's understanding. Respondent filed a reply on July 25, 2024, reiterating its request for the appeal to be dismissed. Subsequently, Appellant and Respondent submitted letters to this court regarding the motion to dismiss and settlement agreement. After careful consideration of the filings, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss.

Additionally, on July 3, 2024, Respondent moved to file and serve its initial brief and designation of matter out of time. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to file out of time. Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter shall be filed and served within thirty days of the date of this order.
