Dear Clerk of the Court of Appeals:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as Appellant’s request for a clarification as to the deadline for her submission of the initial brief and designations pursuant to Rule 208 and 209, SCRAP. As to the relevant procedural history, the undersigned filed a Motion to Stay on August 26, 2024, asking the Court of Appeals to stay the deadlines to permit the trial court to rule on the Appellant’s Rule 59(e) Motion, which was still pending at the time. In addition, the transcript was completed on August 26, 2024, which prompted the undersigned to file the Motion to Stay. However, on August 29, 2024, the trial court ruled on the motion via Form 4 Order, denying it. (Please see enclosed Order). Therefore, the Motion to Stay is now technically moot, however there it has not yet been ruled on.
